The purpose of this letter is to request a recipient change for a Fiscal Year 2026 Congressionally Directed Spending item we previously submitted for consideration in the Senate Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies bill, listed below. We certify that neither of us nor our immediate family have a pecuniary interest in any of the Congressionally Directed Spending items that we have requested, consistent with the requirements of paragraph 9 of Rule XLIV of the Standing Rules of the Senate. We certify that the entity for which we have requested Congressionally Directed Spending is not a for-profit entity. The reason for this change is that Charles County is not a direct FTA recipient. Charles County and the Maryland Transit Administration are partners on this project, and the Maryland Transit Administration will serve as the fiscal sponsor for the project.
